

The poem Who Am 1? was written by Inge Auerbacher some years ago. A radio host spoke of a famous Christmas song, "White Christmas" written by Irving Berlin, a Jew. He then mentioned that U.S. Senator Orrin Hatch, a Mormon had written a song for the Jewish holiday of Hanukkah. This led Inge to composer Madeline Stone who had co-written the song with Hatch.

The song "Who Am I?" was born. Inge contacted the choir ps22 S.I. of New York City director, Gregg Breinberg. She sent a recording to the United Nations; consequently, the choir was invited to sing and Inge to speak at International Holocaust Remembrance Day on 1/28/2019.
